I am pleased to announce that for the second year, Hunt Heroes Foundation, the non-profit organization founded by Hunt Military Communities, will be awarding scholarships to help enable the ongoing education of military members and their families. Last year

we were able to help nine worthy students and awarded \$20,000. Because of the generous donations we received this year, we are able to increase scholarship awards and recognize 12 recipients and award \$30,000 in scholarship grants in 2020. ## PCS Tips for Housing

Permanent Change of Station (PCS) season is approaching and many military members may be gearing up to move from their current home to their new destinations around the globe. With keeping that in mind, here are a few tips for getting ready for PCS season, and moving out of your home.

- Turn in a copy of your orders and fill out a Notice To Vacate at the management office, as soon as possible.
- Call in routine work orders, as soon as they happen.
- Change your mailing address two weeks before your actual move date.
- Visit Self Help over in Maintenance for free touch up paint, light bulbs, and outlet covers, as well as borrow the lawn mower and weed eater if needed.
- Keep in mind that bulk trash days are Tuesday and Thursday (no furniture, appliance or electronics)

## Hunt Loyalty Program

Hunt Honors is our way of giving back to current residents who relocate from base-to-base and continue to live in a Hunt Community. If you are PCS to another Hunt property we will make finding your next home easy as possible.

We will contact the property and provide you with the information and email link to begin the application process.

Residents moving to another Hunt property will be rewarded for their loyalty by receiving a \$100.00 credit towards rent. Residents who sign the lease in advance will receive a \$200.00 credit towards your rent.
