PCS Tips

Housing Permanent Change of Station (PCS) season is approaching and many military members may be gearing up to move from their current home to their new destinations around the globe. With keeping that in mind, here are a few tips for getting ready for PCS season, and moving out of your home.

- Turn in a copy of your orders and fill out a Notice To Vacate at the management office, as soon as possible.
- Call in routine work orders, as soon as they happen.
- Change your mailing address two weeks before your actual move date.
- Visit Self Help over in Maintenance for free touch up paint, light bulbs, and outlet covers, as well as borrow the lawn mower and weed eater if needed.
- Keep in mind that bulk trash days are Tuesday and Thursday (no furniture, appliance or electronics)
