


IT'S BACK TO SCHOOL TIME!

(Bulk trash will still be picked up until then.)



We will now be **ACCEPTING BULK ITEMS AT THE MAINTENANCE OFFICE** Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

There will now be a blue bulk trash dumpster located just inside the gate at the maintenance office. When dropping off items, please check in with the maintenance staff prior to dropping off your items. This will prevent unauthorized items from being put into the dumpsters.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED in the bulk trash container are AC units, refrigerators, freezers, tires, automotive waste, broken glass, fluorescent tube light bulbs, dead animals, paint, vehicle batteries, vehicle parts, and TV's.
