

NAME CHANGE

Fort Lee, a Hunt Military Community, located in Richmond, Virginia, will soon be renamed. This large base of over 1500 military homes is one of several Army bases undergoing a name change. Effective April 27, 2023, Fort Lee will be renamed Fort Gregg-Adams. The new name honors Lt. Gen Arthur Gregg and Lt. Col Charity Adams. Gregg was a key figure in the integration of black soldiers into the Army. Adams was one of the

highest-ranking female soldiers in World War II. Other Army bases receiving name changes include Fort Benning-Fort Moore; Fort Bragg-Fort Liberty; Fort Gordon-Fort Eisenhower; Fort A.P.Hill-Fort Walker; Fort Hood- Fort Cavazos; Fort Pickett-Fort Barfoot; Fort Polk- Fort Johnson; and Fort Rucker- Fort Novosel.

COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

On February 25th, 2020, the Secretary of Defense and Secretaries of the Air Force, Army, and Navy signed the Military Housing Privatization Initiative Tenant Bill of Rights (TBoR). Hunt Military Communities is fully supportive of the initiatives outlined in this document and remains committed to providing the best possible housing for America's Service Members and their families. As part of the TBoR, the Universal Lease was created with State-specific addendums. As of February 1st, 2023, the Air Force approved the Universal Lease (UL) IAW the TBoR for all AF privatized installations. The UL has standardized the lease across the entire Military Family Housing industry. How does this affect you as a tenant? Historically, Active-Duty Service Members (SM) were not required to renew their lease annually as in the civilian housing community. The UL will require all SM's leases to be renewed annually. JBC Family Housing has begun coordinating with SM's whose lease has expired to ensure compliance with AF guidelines and the TBoR.

The UL has specific requirements that all SM's must comply with when renewing your lease. There are two major changes that will be required at renewal they are as follows:

- 1) **RESIDENT INSURANCE:** Owner requires all Tenants to maintain a policy of liability insurance. Issued by an authorized insurance company that provides limits of liability in an amount of at least \$100,000 per occurrence (the "Minimum Required Insurance"). must furnish proof of insurance to the Owner on or before the Lease Commencement Date and, the Tenant must continue to provide evidence of coverage throughout the term hereof. The Owner strongly recommends that the Tenants secure a renter's insurance policy covering the Tenant's personal belongings, which also includes personal liability insurance covering the Tenant's actions.
- 2) PET DEPOSIT: It is agreed between Tenant and Owner that for the privilege of maintaining the above-identified pet(s) within the Premises, the amount of \$250 will be paid as a refundable pet deposit. NOTE: If the pet deposit was paid at move-in, this will be applied to the renewal lease agreement.


