Holiday Decoration and Lighting Guidelines

To maintain the safety, appearance, and integrity of our community, residents are asked to observe the following standards regarding holiday decorations and exterior lighting:

- Placement of Decorations: Holiday decorations and exterior lighting are permitted only when positioned below the edge of the roof gutter. To ensure safety, decorations are not permitted in the second-story areas of the home.
- Attachment Methods: The use of staples, nails, screws, or other mechanical
 fasteners to secure decorations or lighting to homes or associated structures
 is strictly prohibited. Commercially available plastic clip-on hooks can be
 used to attach decorative lighting, garlands, and similar items. Nothing may
 be affixed to vinyl siding.
- Decoration Standards: All holiday decorations must be in good taste and consistent with the traditions and standards of the holiday being observed. Decorations must be removed within one week following the holiday.
- Electrical Safety: All electrical decorations must be unplugged whenever the Tenant is away from the Premises.

Every Thursday is trash pick-up. We do not do bulk pick up, however we do have a dumpster at the maintenance shop that you can take your bulk trash to.

Trash Pick-Up takes place every Thursday. Please have your bins curbside by 7:00 AM for collection.

While bulk trash is not collected curbside, residents are welcome to dispose of large items at the community dumpster located at the maintenance shop, 1597 S O'Neal St. Please note that with the PCS season over, we have returned to our normal hours. The hours are as follows: Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

If you dispose of moving boxes, please break down all cardboard boxes before putting them in the dumpster. No Hazardous waste materials of any kind can be placed in the dumpster.

Hazardous items include: paint, paint cans, liquids, hazardous waste (including oil or any combustible fluids), tires, batteries, electronics (such as TVs), and appliances.

Hazardous items can be disposed of at the Charleston County Landfill, located at 1344 Bees Ferry Rd., or taken to Building 626 on Wednesdays from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM. Call (864) 963-4929 for more information

Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections.
