## COMMUNITY NEWS

February is typically the coldest month of the year, and we want to help everyone stay safe, warm, and prepared as temperatures drop.

Here are a few tips and reminders during freezing conditions:

- Protect your pipes by letting faucets drip slightly, opening cabinet doors to allow warm air to circulate, and insulating any exposed plumbing.
- Set your thermostat no lower than 60 degrees and never turn your heat off, even if you are away.
- Make sure your heat registers or baseboard heaters are not obstructed.
- Prepare for icy conditions by keeping salt or ice melt on hand for walkways and steps, and use caution when walking or driving.
- Bring pets indoors and limit their time outside during extreme cold to keep them safe.
- Keep your garage door closed.

## COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

**Trash Pick Up** - In accordance with the [resident guidelines](#), refuse bins must be at the curb before 7:00 AM on the scheduled pick-up days, unless otherwise instructed by the Community Management Office. If desired, bins can be brought to the curb after 6:00 PM the day before the collection day. Refuse bins must be returned to proper storage by 8:00 PM on the day of collection. Bulk items cannot be dropped off at the curb, but residents can dispose of large items at the community dumpster located at 1597 S O'Neal St.

### Hazardous items include:

- No liquids or hazardous waste, including oil or combustible fluids.
- No batteries.
- No tires.
- No appliances.
- No electronics to include TVs.
- No paint or paint cans.

Hazardous items can be disposed of at Charleston County Landfill at 1344 Bees Ferry Road or taken to building 626 on Wednesdays from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM. Call (864) 963-4929 for more information.
