HURRICANE SEASON – June 1st to November 20th

Prepare an emergency supply kit including:

- Copies of prescription medications and medical supplies.
- Bedding and comfortable clothing, including sleeping bags and pillows.
- Bottled water, a battery-operated radio, extra batteries, a first aid kit, and a flashlight.
- Copies of important documents, including driver’s license, Social Security card, proof of residence, insurance policies, wills, deeds, birth and marriage certificates, tax records, family photos, etc.

Make sure you have a “to-go bag” ready in case you need to evacuate. Include all of the items above, plus:

- Water and non-perishable food.
- Local and state maps.
- Important documents include proof of residence, photos of your family and pets, insurance policies, and tax records.
- Comfortable clothing and blankets.
- Unique family needs such as pet supplies, infant supplies, or any other unique need your family may have.

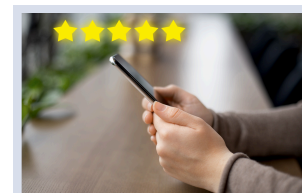
Safety Reminder – WADING POOLS/ SPLASH PADS/SWIMMING POOLS/HOT TUBS

Use of small wading pools, not exceeding 12 inches in height, is authorized only under the following conditions:

- The water must not exceed 12 inches in depth and shall be emptied after use.
- Wading pools are to be constantly monitored by an adult during use and must not be left unattended while holding water.
- Pools are to be emptied, turned over, and properly stored when not in use.
- Grounds damaged by the pools must be restored by the resident.
- Hot tubs, swimming pools, fountains, ponds, or anything that holds water more than 12 inches are prohibited.

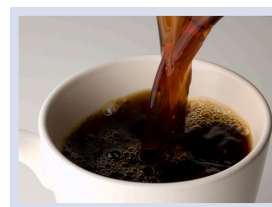

CHARLESTON TOWNE LANDING STATE HISTORIC SITE

Charles Towne Landing State Historic Site in the West Ashley area of Charleston, South Carolina, preserves the original site of the first permanent English settlement in Carolina. Originally opened in 1970 to commemorate South Carolina's tricentennial, this 664-acre site is home to an exhibit hall, a rental facility, a natural habitat zoo, ongoing archeological excavations, miles of trails, dozens of picnic tables, a replica tall ship, six replica cannons, and much more.
