Housing Notices

We just want to remind everyone of the Pet Policy, and that there are only 2 pets per household allowed.

We also want to make sure everyone is cleaning up behind their pets. We have waste stations set up throughout the communities to help assist with this.

All animals, except dogs and cats, must be kept in cages or tanks at all times. Dogs must be confined to the premises or restrained by a leash or fence in the back yard of the premises. Restraint shall include leashing or chaining the animal to a stationary object to preclude the animal from running free or interfering with the normal flow of pedestrians and traffic.

All dogs must be on a leash upon leaving the house and while on Community grounds. Both dogs and cats must be appropriately and effectively restrained and under the control of an individual while on the premises and in the neighborhood.

See pet policy in the Community Hand Book for additional information or contact the management office. Its warming up and kids are playing out front and walking to the playground. Please stop completely at stop signs and look both ways. The speed limit throughout the housing community is 20mph. If you see someone speeding, please contact security forces.
