### Did You Know?

We offer a Deployed Spouses Program, a voluntary program that assists spouses and families of military members who have been deployed with certain tasks including, but not limited to, backyard lawn maintenance, toy assembly and preventative home visits to determine if emergency situations are present. To participate and sign-up, contact the management office at 843-552-0600. There is a Self-Help Program that allows residents to use or borrow supplies and make minor home improvements and individual lawn care and is free to residents only. No charge items at Self-Help includes A/C Filters, Light Bulbs, Range Hood Filters, Switch and Outlet Plates, Drain Stoppers, and Tissue Rollers. Items available for loan are weed trimmers and lawn mowers. Self-Help & Maintenance Office 843-552-3358. Trash collection is every Thursday and Recycling is every other Thursday. The refuse bins must be at the curb before 7:00am on scheduled pick-up day and returned to their proper storage by 8:00pm on the day of collection.
